Definitions for the Category of Trainee

Group 1 (Residency Programs) - May be registered as either a resident or a clinical fellow and be enrolled as follows:

- Any trainee admitted to and enrolled in a Royal College of Physicians & Surgeons of Canada accredited residency program, leading to certification by the RCPSC and/or CFPC in the specialty or subspecialty concerned. **Will always be registered as a resident.**
- Any trainee admitted to and enrolled in a Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada where the trainee has not completed core training in Canada and is therefore not eligible for the usual route of certification with the RCPSC. Will always be registered as a Clinical Fellow at our institution.

Group 2 (Fellowship Programs) - Clinical Fellow:

• A trainee enrolled in all other programs including AFCs and gaining an educational experience **beyond** the requirements of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and/or the College of Family Physicians of Canada residency programs. **There is no exam as part of the training.**

Application Information

Applications are now being accepted and will close on **July 31, 2023** for a July 1, 2024 start. Applications received after this deadline **will not be considered**.

Fellowship applications may have variable dates and have been listed in the table above. Many fellowship programs are already accepting applications for the 2025-2026 academic year.

Residency applications **must** include:

- 2. Curriculum Vitae
- 3. Letter of Intent
- 4. Three (3) Letters of Recommendation
- 5. Copy of Medical Degree
- 6. Full Medical School Transcripts
- Pass standing results for the Medical Council of Canada Qualifying Examination (<u>MCCQE</u>) Part

- 8. Successful results of one of the CPSA accepted English Language Proficiency tests

Incomplete applications will not be considered. University of Alberta application checklists (one for Fellowship applications and one for Residency applications) has been included as attachments to this letter for your convenience to use as a cover page for each application.

English Language Proficiency Requirements:

All applicants must be eligible for a postgraduate trainee permit through the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Alberta (CPSA). The CPSA requires all physicians practising in Alberta to be able to communicate clearly with their patients in English.

Unless exempt, applicants need to complete an academic version of an English Language Proficiency (ELP) test within 24 months before submitting their CPSA application. Applicants can take any of the ELP exams (IELTS Academic, OET Medicine, or CELPIP General) listed on the <u>CPSA website</u>, and **must achieve the minimum passing grade**, per the CPSA.
