English Language Proficiency Requirements:

All applicants must be eligible for a postgraduate trainee permit through the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Alberta (CPSA). The CPSA requires all physicians practising in Alberta to be able to communicate clearly with their patients in English.

Unless exempt, applicants need to complete an academic version of an English Language Proficiency (ELP) test within 24 months before submitting their CPSA application. Applicants can take any of the following ELP exams and must achieve the minimum passing grade:

- IELTS Academic
- OET Medicine examination
- CELPIP General examination
