APPLICATIONS

The application package sent by the sponsoring agency to the Max Rady College PGME Office **must include all of the following items:**

1. A letter from the sponsoring agency which confirms full financial support for the duration of the residency or fellowship program
2. An up-to-date curriculum vitae which includes the applicant's date of birth, citizenship and email address
3. A notarized copy of the medical degree (with English translation, where applicable)
4. A notarized copy of the specialty certification (with English translation, where applicable)
5. Three letters of reference **on letterhead**, signed and dated within two years of the date of application
6. Medical Council of Canada Qualifying Examination Part I Results
7. English is the language of study at the College of Medicine, University of Manitoba. All applicants whose first language is not English must submit proof of proficiency
 - Acceptable English language tests:
 - [International English Language Testing System \(IELTS\)](#) with a minimum score of 7 in each component and an overall band score of no less than 7. IELTS will be considered valid for 2 years from the date taken

Applications lacking any of these items **will not be considered** until the package is complete.
