The Application Deadlines are as follows:

- **August 15, 2021:** PGY-1 residency programs
- **September 1, 2021:** Medical Subspecialty, Pediatric Subspecialty residency applications, and fellowship applications.

These programs have a specific deadline:

- **May 1, 2021:** GREI, Gynecology Oncology
- **August 1, 2021:** Internal Medicine

- There is an application fee of **\$120.99 (non-refundable)** which applies for up to two programs. A maximum of two application files (per applicant) can be sent to us for consideration.
- We are unable to consider incomplete files. Applications received after the application deadlines will not be considered for the 2022-2023 academic year.

Special requirements for the following programs:

**PGY1:**

- **Dermatology:** Fluency in French.
- **General Surgery:** Fluency in English and French.
- **Obstetrics and Gynecology:** Fluency in English and/or French.
- **Psychiatry:** Fluency in English and French.
- **Public Health:** Fluency in French (written and oral), minimum level B1 French.
- **Radiation Oncology:** Basic French.

- **General Internal Medicine:** Basic in French
- **Geriatrics:** Fluency in English and French.
- **Nephrology:** Fluency in English and French.
- **Pediatric Nephrology:** Fluency in English and French.

### **Requirements for the following fellowship programs:**

- **Psychiatry Fellowship:** Please make sure to include a personal statement specific to each application. Evaluations of postgraduate training should be included in the pdf file.
- **Eating Disorders:** Candidates must have French proficiency.
- Applicants in the Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) Fellowship must furnish a work sample, consisting of a videotaped psychotherapy session (preferably but not necessarily CBT) with the consent of a real patient in French or English
- Advanced public health and preventive medicine practice is not opened for applications.
- **Emergency Ultrasound fellowship:** Applications will only be considered if the applicant has already attained significant experience in Core emergency ultrasound applications. The equivalence of Core IP certification as outlined by the Canadian Point of Care Ultrasound Society is preferred.
